Social Studies- the holiday of Valentine's Day. Also President's Day.

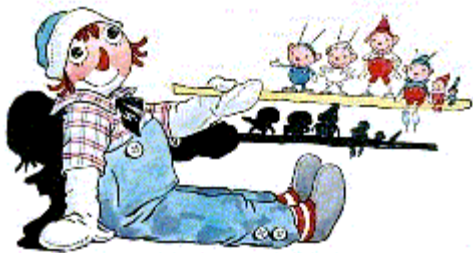
Science: Quails and quarter horses.
