Updates:

- SCA declined payment of \$750 to Bruce Coville, Author, for a 5th & 6th grade assembly due to cost. Bruce will be presenting to the Seven Valley Reading Council.
- SCA declined sale of Syracuse Crunch hockey tickets due to the need to purchase up front and sell out.

Treasurer Report:

- Enjoy the City – raised \$15K; net \$7990. Additional sales raised an additional \$1,497.78. No action will be taken against the outstanding overdrawn checks of \$60 & \$20.

Funding Requests:

- 6th Grade map – Tracie Dugan - \$117.54 and Melissa Sugamele - \$16.99 – SCA approved.
- 3rd Grade CRT trip – Alladin – Cost (SCA funded \$3 per student @ 132 students=\$396 in 2011). SCA approved payment of \$3 per student, as well as covering the additional \$3 for students who are unable to pay.
- 4th Grade Albany trip – SCA approved \$2,500. SCA is unable to sell 50/50 tickets during school hours.
- 5th Grade Play – SCA approved \$300.
- 6th Grade DJ Party – SCA approved \$700 (will provide each teacher with \$100).
