Dear Parent/Guardian:

Members of our local Lions Club have volunteered to provide vision screenings for Homer Elementary School students through their Screening Eyes Early (SEE) mission. The screenings will be provided during the school day, and will be conducted by a Lions Club volunteers with the assistance of the school nurse.

New York State Education Law requires a vision screening of all students as below:

- New entrants
- Students in grades K, 1, 3, and 5
- At any time deemed necessary by school authorities to determine a child's education program

The screening report forms will only have assigned student code numbers to maintain strict confidentiality. The school nurse will provide follow-up screenings, as needed, for students who require such due to initial screening findings or school absence. The school nurse will notify you of any abnormal vision screening results and, as appropriate, the need for referral.

Please notify your school nurse if you **do not** want your child to participate in the vision screening program with the Lions Club.
