FOR STUDENTS

Reminder: all teachers can see your Chromebook screen in live time.

EXPECTATIONS

- Your day at home should mimic what your day at school looks like.
- Get up and around at the same time you normally would.
- Set up your work station for the day.
- During POST follow your teachers directions: Some POST teachers will have you log on and answer a question, others will expect you on a google meet.
- 1st period you work on Freckle for 20 minutes, the other 20 minutes should be spent checking Schooltool, email, and catching up on work.
- 2nd period - 9th period be on your google meets at the start of each class until you are dismissed.
- Be mindful of the clock and be on time to google meets.
- You will be expected to complete work as you would in the classroom
- Ask questions!

HELPFUL TIPS

GOOGLE CLASSROOM

Google Classroom is what your child uses to log onto their google meets, meet with their class, and turn in their assignments. Your child will have to log in for you to access Google Classroom.

To see which assignments are due daily/weekly in an organized list ...

- Log into your child's Google Classroom
- Click the three horizontal lines at the top left corner
- Click on "To Do"

SCHOOLTOOL

Schooltool is used to check overall averages and grades on assignments. If you don't have a login when you get to Schooltool click on the blue link at the top that says "*Parent Portal Access: Parents click here to create an account or if you forgot your username."

Once logged into Schooltool

- Click on your child's picture
 - Click assignments
 - Click the blue i for overall averages or use the drop down button to see specific subjects and assignments
