Dear Homer Schools Community,

In an effort to get information to you as soon as possible and to compensate for the delay in delivery of mailings, below please find the school day schedules for all four of our district buildings. As I have mentioned throughout the school reopening process, the potential for modest changes to our daily building schedules could occur to accommodate our family transportation requests. With that in mind, please find each schools' daily schedule.

At Homer Elementary School, the school day will run from 9am to 3:30pm. All three elementary locations – Homer High School for Pre-K, Homer Elementary School for Kindergarten and 1st Grade and the Intermediate School for 2nd grade will begin screening and be accessible by students beginning at 9am. Walkers will be dismissed at 3:05 p.m. with bussers to follow.

At Homer Intermediate School, screening will begin and students may enter the building at 9:00 am and will be dismissed at 3:20 p.m. Students need to be in their homeroom by 9:20 am to be on time.

At Homer Junior High, the building will be open to screen students beginning at 7:35 a.m. We are asking that parent's complete drop off by 7:50 a.m. to help with the flow of students into the building. Dismissal for our students using school bus transportation will begin at 2:15. Dismissal for our students walking or being picked up by a parent will begin at 2:25. We are asking that all students be picked up by 2:45 p.m.

At Homer High School, students will be able to enter the building at 7:50 a.m. At the end of the day, walkers and student drivers will be released at 2:17 p.m. with bus dismissal taking place at 2:28 p.m.

You will receive, if you haven't already, a mailing from your child's school with all of the specific information you will need to prepare for your child to begin the school year on the right foot on September 10<sup>th</sup>. Students who will be learning from home will receive their information from both the school and teacher level.

We appreciate your patience as we continue to plan for what will be a very positive 2020-2021 school year. Take care and thank you for entrusting your child's education to us.
