 This increase in spending will be offset by an increase in revenues through New York State Aid.





## PROPOSITION I 2023-24 Budget

Shall the Board of Education of the Homer Central School District be authorized to expend the sums set forth in the same amount of \$47,195,532.00 to levy the necessary tax therefore.



## **PROPOSITION II**

# **Bus Leasing & Purchase of Vehicles**

Shall the following resolution be adopted: resolved that, pursuant to chapter 472 of the session laws of 1998, the Board of Education of the Homer Central School District is hereby authorized to lease and expend therefore, including costs incidental thereto an amount not to exceed the estimated maximum cost of One million and One hundred thousand dollars (\$ 1,100,000) and for a term not to exceed five (5) years, the following motor vehicles: Seven (7) sixty-six (66) passenger school buses and One (1) Wheelchair Bus.

and

The Board of Education of the Homer Central School District is hereby authorized to purchase and expend therefore, including costs incidental thereto and the financing thereof, an amount not to exceed the estimated maximum cost of One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) the following motor vehicles: three (3) vans; and, that such sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax collected in annual installments; and that in anticipation of such tax, obligations of the district shall be issued.

# **PROPOSITION III**

#### **Student Member on Board of Education**

Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Homer Central School District is hereby authorized to have a student attending high school within the District serve as an ex officio student member of the Board of Education; such ex officio student member being entitled to sit with Board of Education members at all public meetings of the Board of Education and participate in all Board of Education hearings and meetings, but not vote, attend executive session, and/or be entitled to receive compensation of any form for participating at Board of Education meetings; and

Be it further Resolved, that the Board of Education of the Homer Central School District is authorized to establish a process for selection of such ex officio student member of the Board of Education pursuant to Education Law §1702.

# **PROPOSITION IV**

### **Phillips Free Library Funding**

Shall the Board of Education of the Homer Central School District be authorized to increase the annual levy of taxes for the use of the Phillips Free Library from two hundred and three thousand, nine hundred and twenty-three dollars (\$203,923) to two hundred and eight thousand, six hundred and five dollars (\$208,605), and to pay over such monies annually to the trustees of the Phillips Free Library of Homer, New York.
